LETTER OF INTENT

Agreement of Cooperation between The Pontifical Faculty of Theology in Warsaw and The Faculty of Catholic Theology, University of Sarajevo

Both parties have decided to formally confirm and develop their cooperation, which for both of them is of great importance, especially because of the fact that both faculties have both state and canon entitlements.

Both faculties represent mutually complementing theological, spiritual and cultural legacy and at the same time are both open to mutual development in sharing the experience in academic research, especially of the theological, humanistic and social-political fields.

The Pontifical Faculty of Theology in Warsaw, based at Dewajtis 3, 01-815 Warszawa, Poland, represented by

and

The Faculty of Catholic Theology, University of Sarajevo, based at Josipa Stadlera 5, 71 000 Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, represented by,

The Dean of The Faculty of Catholic Theology, University of Sarajevo, Reverend Professor Darko Tomašević

have concluded the agreement below which states that both parties confirm:

- 1. The exchange of the lecturers, ensuring the emolument for their lectures. The emolument is dependent on the amount of lecture hours and the lecturer's academic degree. The requirement as to the lecturer is that he/she has at least a good command of the English or Italian language or the lecture language of the faculty in question.
- 2. Mutual information about, and invitations, to symposia and academic conferences. The lecturers of both faculties may be at any time invited with a speech or lecture to such meetings. In that case the date, the length and the language of the speech will be individually agreed.

- 3. The exchange of lecturers for the purpose of academic research. In certain cases the faculty is entitled to delegate, for the same period of time, a student of the second or third cycle of theology (licentiate of sacred theology or doctorate). In that case a written recommendation of the Dean is required.
- 4. An exchange of one issue of academic periodicals published at PWTW (Warszawskie Studia Teologiczne and Studia Bobolanum) and all other representative monographic works published at the Pontifical Faculty of Theology in Warsaw.
- 5. A free of charge exchange of all extra copies of a book edition between the universities libraries.
- 6. A free access to the library of the guest lecturer with compliance with the particular university library regulations.
- 7. Deepening, developing and seeking future mutual cooperation extending the above commitments. If a need arises the above agreement can be annexed or corrected by mutual agreement. The agreement acquires the force of law on the moment of signing by both parties.
